- Work with project managers/principals in multiple offices to support and contribute to project design work, preparing planting plans, and site grading, construction document, and specification preparation;
- Serve as a technical resource to support projects and manage tasks and projects;
- Assist in the development of presentations, technical documents, and reports; and
- Be responsive to managers and clients in support of project implementation; ensure timely, cost effective, high-quality service, and product delivery.

**Requirements:**

- Entering final year of obtaining Bachelor degree (minimum) and currently pursuing a Masters level degree (preferred) in Landscape Architecture. It is desirable, but not necessary, for candidates to also be pursuing a degree(s) in architecture, Horticulture, Environmental Sciences, Ecology, City and Regional Planning, or urban design.
- It is desirable to have a strong foundation in planting and ecological design, plant communities, and restoration planting.
- Interest or experience with neighborhood planning and civic design.
- Interest or experience working with non-profit clients, community groups, government clients, and private clients.

**Proficiencies:**

- Competent writing, presentation, and verbal communication skills.
- Strong hand drawing, hand drafting, and hand rendering skills. Portfolios and/or samples of work should illustrate the applicant's artistic strengths beyond computer aided graphics. Hand drawings should illustrate the applicant's skills in design process; diversity of media; and understanding of object scale, form, depth, etc. beyond the digital design environment.
- Experience preparing and assembling presentation graphics, Digital 3D models and renderings, and construction document and construction detailing preparation.
- Experience in plant identification, preparing planting plans, and site grading
- Experience and/or proficiency in AutoCAD, AutoCAD Civil 3D/3D Map, Rhinoceros, Sketch Up Pro, Google Earth Pro, Adobe Creative Suites, MS Office, and AutoCAD 3DS Max. (It is desirable that applicants have a high proficiency in all or most software packages listed)
- Portfolio samples of work should illustrate the candidate's strength of understanding in graphic and written presentation as well as software and hand drawing/sketching/drafting proficiencies.
